Dr. Roy holds an MS in General Surgery, as well as an MPH from John Hopkins University. He currently is the Head of the Department of Surgery at BARC Hospital, a 300-bed community healthcare provider to 100,000 people in Mumbai, India (the second most populous city in the world). He is also involved with the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), the apex institute for Nuclear Preparedness in India. Dr. Roy is a Visiting Professor at Jamshedji Tata Centre of Disaster Management, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, in Mumbai, India. The Jamshedji Tata Centre for Disaster Management trains disaster managers from various specialties, in the developing world context. His teaching there focuses on Public Health in Disasters and Ethics in complex humanitarian emergencies. His interests in disaster health include trauma delivery systems, violence, emergency medicine, patient safety, and public health disaster preparedness in South Asia.
