

## **DR. PINCHAS HALPERN, MD**



Pinchas ("Pinny") Halpern, M.D., is Senior Lecturer in Anesthesia, Critical Care and Emergency Medicine, Tel Aviv University, and Visiting Professor at the Free Universities of Brussels and Eastern Piedmont in Italy. He is Chair, Department of Emergency Medicine, Tel Aviv Sourasky Medical Center, in Tel Aviv, Israel.

Dr. Halpern trained in Anesthesiology in Tel Aviv and in Critical Care Medicine at the Ohio State University. He is former President of the Israeli Association for Emergency Medicine, member of Israeli National EMS Board of Directors, and its Chair of the Medical Committee. He is on the national CBRN Advisory Committee and the National Trauma Board, and is Chair - National Taskforce on Mechanical Ventilation in Disasters. He is also Chairman of Continuing Medical Education in Emergency Medicine, Tel Aviv University and on the staff of the European Master of Disaster Medicine.

Dr. Halpern led training missions in Emergency and Disaster Medicine to Ethiopia, Uzbekistan, Azerbaijan, Turkey, Jordan, Poland, and USA and participated in disaster relief efforts in the Turkey earthquake of 1999 as head of the intensive care unit of the Israeli Army Field Hospital.
