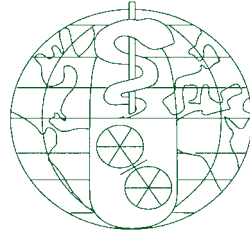

THE SCOPE OF WADEM

Currently, members receive information and participate in an international link with their peers through five major venues:

- 1. The Biennial World Congress**, where members and interested participants present scientific reports on emergency and resuscitation research, disaster planning and response, and changes in systems of providing prehospital care.
- 2. *Prehospital and Disaster Medicine***, the only peer-reviewed international journal in its field, published bi-monthly, providing a readable, usable worldwide source of research and analysis.
- 3. *WADEM Insight***, a bimonthly newsletter that includes news of interest to the membership.
- 4. Task Forces** on Nuclear, Biological and Chemical Hazards; Terrorism; Psychosocial; Planning; Public Health; Refugees/Internally Displaced Persons; Transportation; Civilian-Military Collaboration; Coordination and Control; Infectious Diseases and Epidemics; and Landmines, all of which strive to identify problems in their areas and work toward constructive solutions.
- 5. *WADEM Chapters*** consists of members organized geographically to promote the goals of *WADEM* cooperatively. Chapters have an academic and research focus, share professional experiences and provide educational and research opportunities to advance disaster and emergency healthcare and management in their region.
- 6. *Nursing Insight***, a critical reviews of pertinent disaster nursing literature published electronically three times a year.

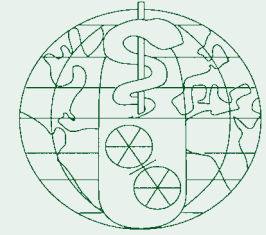

Founded in 1976 at the Club of Mainz

The Club of Mainz was founded on October 2, 1976 with the goal of improving the worldwide delivery of prehospital, emergency, and disaster health care during everyday and mass disaster emergencies. The founding members were renowned researchers, practitioners, and teachers of acute care medicine who joined together to focus their energies on the scientific, educational and clinical aspects of immediate care.

Following the constant expansion of its scope and extension worldwide, and to better reflect its nature, the organization's name was changed to the World Association for Disaster and Emergency Medicine (*WADEM*).

While *WADEM* has grown over the years, the founding principles have remained the same. Our members continue to actively work to solve scientific, technical, and political problems surrounding the planning for and management of emergency incidents. Through their dedication, and with your help, we can better provide pioneering solutions and meaningful changes in our disaster-ridden world.
